

Coronavirus Economic Stimulus Package Project

130 Points

In this project you are going to *research and report* on important information about the 2020 Coronavirus Aid Relief Package that was approved by President Donald Trump. You have a few options on how you can relay the below information to your viewers:

1. Traditional Presentation using Google Slides - submit by attaching your Google Slide to the Google Classroom
2. Interactive Presentation using Prezi - submit by pasting the link to your Prezi to the Google Classroom
3. Infographic using Canva - submit by downloading your Infographic as a PDF or JPG document and attaching to the Google Classroom
4. News Report using a video on your phone or other recording device - submit by uploading your video to the Google Classroom

- Below in **bold** are the topics that you will cover in your presentation. All of the *sub questions* need to be addressed clearly through the medium that you chose to present your information.
- Try to answer these questions in order or clearly label or identify the questions so I don't miss any during the grading process.
- **Note:** *I have linked ONE resource under each section to give you a head start. You might need to go above and beyond that resource to find all the answers.*

Coronavirus Economic Stimulus Package Overview: (25 Points - 5 Points Each)

1. *What is a stimulus package?*
2. *How much money did President Trump approve for the stimulus package in total?*
3. *Why is the government approving a stimulus package?*
4. *How do you think people will spend their money and how will it improve the economy?*
5. **Using the graph on the LAST PAGE**, *what surprises you most about how the funds were allocated? Are there any you would decrease or increase?*

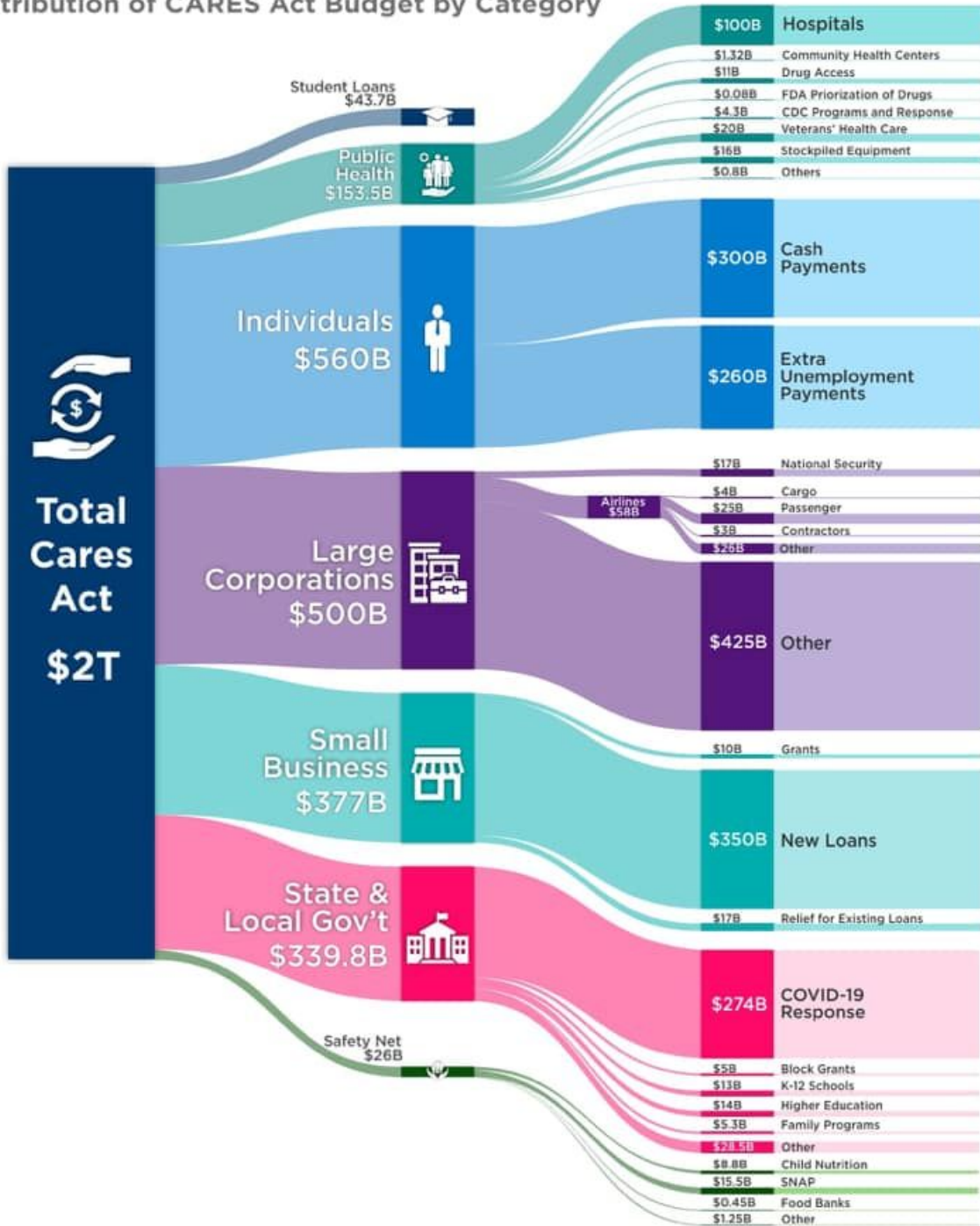
1. *Pictures*
